Fire Fighter III – Ice Rescue

Perform an Entry Ice Rescue – Webbing Loop

Evaluator Instructions: The candidate shall be provided with a cold water survival suit, ice picks, tender line and carabiners, webbing loop

Task: Demonstrate techniques utilized to efficiently and safely remove a victim from water

Performance Outcome: The candidate shall be able to safely and efficiently move to the victim, select area to enter, enter water correctly, and maintain control of victim while with assistance from shore tenders remove the victim and themselves from the water

Candidate Directive: Given the proper PPE the rescuer will travel across ice on foot and once approaching open water lie prone and move off to side of area where victim is located. Rescuer enters water correctly, bleeding suit of entrapped air and maintaining buoyancy, assists with maneuvering victim onto ice shelf, indicates to shore tenders that retrieval is now needed, and positions themselves up onto ice shelf while at same time maintaining control of victim

1	Ensures all necessary equipment assembled and connected correctly				
2	Enters water by correct method allowing suit to purge air				
3	Initiates contact with victim and maintains throughout rescue				
4	Passes webbing loop to victim and assists victim with placing loop over head and both arms.				
5	Maneuver so that dominant arm is able to assist with rescue and non dominant shoulder is up on top of ice shelf				
6	Calls for shore tender line to haul both rescuer and victim onto ice while maintaining control of victim at all times
