	The majority of the students will not have used fire service terminology or equipment. It is important that the basic terms and the systems used in the various areas be explained. Role playing should be used to place students into situations that require clear and concise communication.

Phone Communications

SE4-S1

Provide your name and the facility being called. Example: "Rogers Fire Station this is Captain Meredith speaking, how may I help you".

Non-Emergency Call

- 1. Answer as pleasantly and quickly as possible
- 2. Answer questions carefully do not to give out information on sensitive department matters.
- 3. Transfer calls tactfully "Please hold the line" or page
- 4. Always say "please" and "thank you"
- 5. Ask to take a message if person called is unavailable

Emergency Call

- 1. caller's name
- 2. caller's phone number
- 3. location of incident
- 4. incident type

EXAMPLE OF TYPES OF SCENERIOS

Calling for information:

Need to speak to:

Fire Alarm Activation: Have students operate in different areas of a large building to identify any conditions or activated devices located.

A missing person: Have the students search the parking lot area and identify how may silver vehicles in their sector and describe the vehicles location.

Reported Building Fire: Isolate the student and picture from the rest of the class. Ask the class to write a brief description of what they see based on the radio information provided. Discuss the results and identify methods that could have improved the accuracy of the report.

Other: The Instructor may use incidents or other assignments, however it is important to remember the class has not received the information or instruction for fire operations yet.
