A variety of interactive teaching methods are used effectively to foster engagement.</p> <p>Indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most students are actively engaged, showing interest and participation in activities. • Successfully employs a mix of lecture, discussion, and interactive activities to engage students. • Uses questioning techniques and discussions effectively to encourage student interaction. • Receives positive feedback on engagement from students. 	<p>Definition: The instructor excels in creating a highly engaging and interactive learning environment, where students are deeply involved and motivated. Innovative engagement strategies are employed, resulting in exceptional levels of participation and interest.</p> <p>Indicators:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are highly engaged, with evident enthusiasm and active participation in all activities. • Utilizes a dynamic range of teaching methods and interactive activities that significantly enhance engagement. • Employs advanced questioning techniques and fosters meaningful discussions that deeply engage students. • Receives outstanding feedback on engagement from students, highlighting a transformative learning experience.
