Claiming Your RespondNH Account

All NH EMS Providers and anyone who has taken a course with FST-EMS have an account with RespondNH already. Only <u>Individuals who have never filled out a General Admission Application, taken</u> <u>an online course through the FST-EMS site, or applied for a NH EMS Provider License</u> will need to create new RespondNH accounts.

Procedure

- 1. Navigate to <u>https://www.respondnh.org</u> We recommend using Google Chrome as the web-browser.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the main page and look for the "Login" Section:

If you are an EMS Provider in the state or otherwise have an active TEMSIS account, your account credentials should be the same as your TEMSIS account. Please use your TEMSIS login and password to claim your RespondNH Account. If your password is not the same, choose "Forgot Password", and your password for both systems will be reset via an email link.

Current & Former NHFA and Bureau of EMS Students:

- Please choose: "Forgot Username"
- Enter the Last four of your Social Security Number, Date of Birth, and Last Name. Then click the "Lookup" button.
- All three criteria must match exactly for RespondNH to find your existing account.
